

Pupils commented that they do not like that the public throw things over the fence, especially into the outdoor learning area (e.g. dog poo bags, litter etc)

Pupils felt very safe with the taxi system at the start and end of the day.

Within the art room, Post 16 kitchen and the technology room pupils discussed that the equipment can make them nervous, however the levels and the support of staff mitigate this and help them work through their nerves.

Pupils like the crossing in the car park, it makes them feel safer.

Pupils explained the busyness of the corridors makes them nervous, but staff levels make this feel safer.

Pupils do not like using the traffic island to enter the minibus. New process to be put in place.

Pupils discussed that the front entrance can make them nervous at the beginning and end of day with their being strangers there. They felt that the new entrance made this safer.

Pupils explained they used to feel unsafe with the door system at the PE department but feel much safer now it is key managed.

Pupils talked about explicit teaching to stay safe in the computing suite.

Pupils reported not liking the first toilet in post 16 as the modesty curtain does not come across far enough.

Pupils discussed that they feel nervous about the public being able to look into the playground, dogs coming up to the fence, objects coming into the playground.

Pupils discussed that sometimes the locks can stick on the toilets in this corridor. The window to the swing room can also be a little 'scary' with it being dark inside.

Pupils talked about feeling nervous with the noise in the sports hall and with the dining hall. However commented that the levels of staff make them feel safer and they know they have options to leave if they are overwhelmed.
