## **Parent Governor Vacancy for Percy Hedley School**

We wanted to inform you that the term for one our current parent governors is coming to an end. They have expressed their willingness to continue in the role, but we also welcome new applications from parents who may be interested in joining the governing body. Parent Governors are elected by and from the parents of children currently attending our school. They serve up to a four-year term of office and bring a very important and valued perspective to the work of the Governing Body.

We would particularly welcome nominations from parents from diverse ethnic backgrounds as we are underrepresented in that area. We are committed to the diversity of our school and would like our governing board membership to demonstrate this.

The governing body has a vital role to play in making sure every child receives the best possible education. This is achieved by ensuring that governors have the necessary skills and commitment to contribute to the effective governance and success of the school. It is expected that governors will make use of the various training opportunities available to them and play a full part in the work of the governing body.

Whilst previous experience of school governance is useful, this is by no means a pre-requisite for this role as full support and induction training is provided. Most importantly, we seek a Parent Governor who has a passion for inclusive education and is keen to work in a supportive but challenging way with the Senior Leadership of the school to ensure the continued delivery of high-quality education for children of the families in our community.

The Governing Body is responsible for the conduct of the school and for promoting high standards and carries out its role by supporting the vision for the school and ensuring that the school works effectively towards achieving its vision. It does this by building a thorough knowledge of the school and its community, by supporting and constructively challenging the school.

The Governing Body is made up of Parent Governors, Staff Governors and Co-opted Governors who are expected to:

- Attend 1 meeting per term with perhaps other short Keeping in Touch meetings
- Visit the school formally for monitoring purposes at least once a term
- Attend training courses, perform additional research as required and take part in oversight of at least one area of the school's work
